

SQL Monitor 3.5 release notes

New feature

SQL Monitor automatically creates a baseline against which you can compare previous metric activity. You can:

- Set the baseline to include metric data collected during single or multiple previous time ranges.
- Choose between two different views of the Analysis graph:
 - Lines view: each time range included in the baseline is represented by a separate line. This helps you to spot behavioral trends.
 - Regions view: shaded regions help you to quickly identify the areas where metric activity occurred most frequently, and shows whether your latest data pattern falls outside the normal limits for your server.
