

Unregister-SqlChangeAutomation

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Deactivates SQL Change Automation

Syntax

```
Unregister-SqlChangeAutomation [<CommonParameters>]
```

Description

This unregisters a SQL Change Automation serial number previously registered on this machine.

Parameters

<CommonParameters>

Inputs

The input type is the type of the objects that you can pipe to the cmdlet.

Return values
