## Remove-InstantCloneConnection

### Syntax

```
Remove-InstantCloneConnection -ConnectionName <string> [<CommonParameters>]  
Remove-InstantCloneConnection -ConnectionId <string> [<CommonParameters>]
```

### Parameters

#### **-ConnectionId** <System.String>

The connection Id to remove.

#### **-ConnectionName** <System.String>

The connection name to remove.

Aliases	None
Required?	true
Position?	named

#### **<CommonParameters>**

### Inputs

The input type is the type of the objects that you can pipe to the cmdlet.

### Return values

The output type is the type of the objects that the cmdlet emits.

## Examples

### ----- EXAMPLE 1 -----

```
Remove-InstantCloneConnection -Id 79514603-B53E-4D85-98C8-D3D24DBDFF1C
```

Removes the connection with Id 79514603-B53E-4D85-98C8-D3D24DBDFF1C.

### ----- EXAMPLE 2 -----

```
Remove-InstantCloneConnection -Name .\sql2012
```

Removes the connection with Name .\sql2012.
